- Venue:This competition will be held at Corby East Midlands International Swimming Pool,
Parkland Gateway, George Street, Corby.NN17 1QB Telephone: 01536 464643

- **Car Parking:** Available directly outside the pool for around 400 cars. There is additional parking at the Oasis car park which is about a 2 minute walk from the pool. The approximate cost of these car parks are 60p/2 hours.
- **Pool:** An 8 lane 50 metres pool with a separate warm down pool.
- **Timing:** Colorado electronic timing with 8 line scoreboard is to be used in conjunction with a computerised entry and results.
- **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is **£6.00** per event when submitted to your club Gala administrator who will then forward them electronically. It will be **£6.50** if submitted individually via a paper entry form direct to Corby swimming club.
- **Coaches Pass:** Coaches Passes are available to Coaches/Team Managers supporting competing swimmers. This will include poolside admission, programme, poolside drinks and lunch. To assist with catering Coach Passes **must** be ordered with entries. When ordering coach passes please ensure their DBS numbers are enclosed. The cost of a day pass is £10.

Coaches' Passes will not be sold on the day.

There must be sufficient poolside supervision for clubs to maintain adequate supervision of their swimmers. As a guide, a ratio of 1:10 Adults to Swimmers [inc Coach/Team Manager] should be considered as the minimum requirement which should include male and female adults to reflect the swimmers if the team is made up of male and female swimmers. Clubs with twenty or less swimmers should apply for a two passes; but where there are more than twenty swimmers, a club should apply for additional passes to maintain a 1:10 ratio of adults to swimmers.

- **Refreshments:** The Swimming Pool has a small café which serves hot & cold food. There are also some vending machines in the café area. As the pool is located in Corby town centre there are numerous shops and restaurants with in easy access to the pool
- Health & Safety: All participants and spectators must observe the health & safety precautions in operation at the Corby Swimming Pool. The swimming pool and changing room areas are only available to competitors, Coaches, Officials and not to parents or carers. The Spectators balcony is available to those supporting the swimming. Access will be controlled to these areas.

The remainder of the pool complex is still open to the public for Gymnasium, Group classes and Health Suite including the café area.

The use of photography is not permitted by visitors, spectators or competitors unless their details have been registered at the swimming pool Reception and a label displayed on their person to show you have done so.

It is vital that stairs, walkways and thoroughfares must be kept clear of persons or bags.

There are no expected Fire Alarms so should the fire alarm sound spectators and coaches should evacuate the building immediately. Swimmers have a two stage evacuation and if the alarm sounds swimmers should follow the lifeguard's directions and queue up alongside the poolside fire exits. Should swimmers need to evacuate then they will leave by the fire escapes having been given foil blankets. The assembly point is by the Corby Cube (Large glass Building) to the left of the main entrance as you exit the swimming pool.

If a competitor has any known condition that may affect the swimmer during the meet then the meet promoter and the referee should be notified in writing before the meet. This information will be passed onto the pool staff to ensure they have the appropriate level of people to deal with any potential problem occurring during the gala.

Swim Shop: A Swim Shop will be present on the day located by the main entrance to the building.

Photography: There will be no professional photography at this event. Mobile Phones and devices with an Image capturing facility can only be used pool side providing the Image capturing device is not used or registration is completed at reception and a sticker prominently displayed on their person. Anyone caught capturing an image without authorisation to do so will be asked to remove it from their device and may be expelled from the event.

The Competition is open to amateur swimmers as defined by the ASA Laws. All entrants must be registered as Category 2 members.

Age as 7th October 2017 for the following age groups: 10 and under, 11/12, 13/14,
15/16, 17 and over. Minimum Age: 9 years on the day of the Competition.Entries:Entries must be made on the Individual Entry Forms attached with submitted times to
your Club administrator. Qualification times must be personal best times in 25m pool
format and be no faster than the attached table in the respective Age Groups for
Consideration for Entry.

This meet will be run electronically. Clubs sending more than 3 swimmers in total will need to submit entries electronically using Sportsys Entry Manager along with the entry and official's summary sheets. A single payment either by cheque or BACs must be made when submitting entries. Club entries will only be processed once the electronic entry file, payment, entry summary sheet and summary of officials are received. The Sportsys entry file can be requested from 1st July onwards via email. secretary@corbyswimmingclub.org.uk or team.admin@corbyswimmingclub.org.uk

Any paper entries (no more than 3 swimmers from any one club) must be on the official entry form, and must include the entrants Name, ASA registration number, DOB and submitted times together with correct entry fees. (These individual paper entries will incur an extra fee)

Payment will only be accepted by single cheque payable to Corby Amateur Swimming Club or BACs to the Account No. 46838759, Sort Code 60-06-11. No entries will be registered unless the correct payment has been received.

For seeding purposes entry times must be submitted. Failing to submit a time will result in exclusion of the swimmer from that event. Dependent on the number of entries the Promoter reserves the right to restrict the number of entries to facilitate the meet running time. (i.e. First come, first served).

No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to promoters error or omission. Refund of entry fees will be made for rejected entries or where the entry to an event has had to be restricted. For any other reason refund of entry fees will only be made up until the closing date for entries or at the discretion of the Promoter.

Officials: Clubs taking part are asked if they can help provide officials that will both commit to attending and will be willing to mentor trainees if numbers allow.





Late Entries:	Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date. Entries received without payment or incorrectly completed may be rejected.
Warm-up:	Warm up details as noted previously. Warm up procedures will be listed at diving end of the pool. Diving is only permitted in designated sprint lanes. And this will be announced 5 minutes from the end of each 20 minute warm up session.
	Competitors must report to the Marshalling steward when they are called. Any competitor not reporting in time may be excluded. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager and Coaches to ensure that their competitors report to the marshalling stewards in time for the start of their race.
Withdrawals:	There will be a withdrawal system in operation. These should be forwarded to the recorders desk by the coaches/Team Managers before the warm up of that session has started. If a swimmer withdraws once the draw has been completed for any reason other than illness, then they will not be allowed to compete in any further events within this gala.
Start:	To maintain the scheduled timing of events all starts will be over the top, except backstroke races.
Seeding of Heats:	All heats will be swum fully integrated and in spearhead formation time order.
Winners:	All events are HDW (Heat Declared Winners) for each age group.
Awards:	Individual medals will be awarded for the first 3 places in each age group for each event. Medals may be collected from the designated collection point when results are posted (They will not be sent out after the gala). Results will also be available to view and download from the Corby Amateur Swimming Club once an event has been completed. website - www.corbyswimmingclub.org.uk
Admissions:	The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
Conduct:	It is the responsibility of the Club's Team Manager and/or the Lead Coach at the meet to ensure that the conduct of their swimmers is of the appropriate standard at all times. Those individuals are also responsible for the safety of their swimmers, including their welfare at all times. Failure of coaches and/or Team Managers to control their swimmer's actions and protect their swimmer's welfare, and possibly the welfare of others, may result in complete expulsion from the meet.
	Please respect not only the people involved in running the meet, but also the Pool Centre staff, the building and facilities as well as members of the General public who will have access to certain areas of the building during the meet.
	Please ensure that all litter is placed in the bins/ bags provided around the pool.
Health &	All swimmers should have suitable footwear on when not in the changing rooms or poolside.

Safety:For Health and Safety reasons at the end of each event swimmers must remain in
their lanes in the pool until released by the referee.
