All 8 of our swimmers are midland qualifiers and are in training for that competition, so here at Norwich personal best times would be difficult to come by but our swimmers still came up trumps they made 13 finals and finished the weekend with 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 4 bronze medals, 15 long course PBs, 8 converted PBs & 3 MQTs so all in all a very good Easter weekend for Deepings swimmers

Louis Metselaar gained the most PBs (2LCPBs & 4 converted PBs) and two new Midland Qualifying Time on this occasion. He had a very good weekend bring home two bronze medals for his swims in the 50m Breaststroke and 50m Fly making him our top boy swimmer of Easter.

Bailie Harrison had a good weekend; she made all 3 finals in the events she had chosen to compete in and came home with a full house of medals. She won the 100m Butterfly, took silver in the 100m Backstroke and bronze in 50m Butterfly she was our top girl swimmer.

Holly Leggott was unlucky not to bring home a medal as she was just fingertips away from a bronze in the 200m Backstroke, we went on to make 3 finals but was unable to pick up a medal on this occasion. She did achieve two long course PBs.

Jessie Spooner after swimming two events in the morning Jessie took on the 800m Freestyle in the afternoon session and I'm sure she was pleased she did as she picked up a bronze medal for her efforts, what a nice Easter gift!

Bethany Eagle-Brown was also unlucky not to bring home bronze for her swim in the final of the 50m Freestyle which was a new long course PB. She also made the 100m Freestyle final where she was ranked 6 in the heats but she improved to 5<sup>th</sup> in the final.

Kallum Penman despite finishing 9<sup>th</sup> in the 100m Fly he was elevated into the final when a swimmer dropped out. He took his opportunity to show what he could do and managed to improve on his heat time to finish 7<sup>th</sup> showing he deserved his place in that final.

Jake Jungmann who is off to the Midland this month had two good swims in his events. His 50m backstroke swim was still well under the MQT so we wish him well.

Lorna McGill qualified for the Midlands in the 200m breaststroke at Leicester Age Group Meet at the beginning of March; here at Norwich she was attempting the event long course for the very first time before those championships. She gained valuable experience but was unable to improve on her current time but did gain two new long course PBs.
