Following the directives of the Athlete Development Support Pathway (ADSP) set out below are the individual Squad standards.

These standards are designed for the individual to promote and encourage Leicestershire's talented athletes in the pursuit of excellence in swimming.

In addition to the above
Swimmers must compete in events as directed by the Head/Squad Coach.
Swimmers are required to wear COLSC branded kit at designated events.
Swimmers are expected to show a high level of self motivation.
Swimmers must display a positive and respectful attitude at training and competitions.
Swimmers must show respect to all COLSC officers, coaches, members and parents at all
times.
Swimmers must show respect to all officials, officers and other competitors at all times.

Achieving the objective standards does not automatically qualify you for that level. Membership or progression require other factors for a position to be awarded. Set out below is the Squad Charter.

Candidates must be a paid-up member of a Leicestershire base club affiliated to LASA. Requests to join COLSC performance program must be made in cooperation with the base club. The swimmer's maturity will be considered in awarding a squad position. A high level of swim skills must be evident relative to the squad position being awarded.

You must commit to competitive swimming as your primary sport.

A squad position can only be awarded when a position is available.

The Head Coach will be the final arbiter taking into consideration the criteria and any other factors.
